Objective

The objective of this function is to hunt the talent and strengthen the dramatic society of university. We want students to adopt the culture of sophistication, decency and confidence by participating in this society. Dramatic society has been inculcating the spirit of competition among students. It infuses the love for art and literature among students.

Rules and Regulations of the Participation

Curtain : No curtain drop in between will be allowed. Lights can go on and off for scene / costume changes.

Set – Single Set encouraged. Please note that set design, fabrication and tear down will be participating team's responsibility. Drama Competition Committee members might work with the directors of the selected teams on specific set requirements only on a limited case by case basis. You're encouraged to keep your set design simple and restricted to a single set for the whole drama. Also, storage in the theater is limited and will need to be shared with other participating teams.

Audio Setup: We will provide a fixed setup of microphones.

There will be no stage rehearsal time.

Use of any of the team's own audio or light equipment is normally not allowed. Special cases may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

All members of the teams need to be registered for this competition. (Registration form is attached with this letter).

Language of Drama: English, Urdu and Punjabi

Theme of Drama/ mime: Contemporary Social Issues like Injustices, Class Differences, Psychological conflicts, Materialism, Failure in relationships Unemployment and Positive activity in GCUF etc. Terrorism is excluded from the list of themes.

Timing: A Maximum time of 20 minute is allocated for **Drama**

A maximum time of 15 minute is allocated for **Mime**.

Script Selection:

Script selections should be reflective of the maturity level of the performers and in keeping with the family-type audience that is usually in attendance. Directors and principals must be sensitive to the appropriateness of their script choices, particularly when another host school is providing your venue. Principals and directors who choose scripts with language or situations that could offend audiences at a host school should consider seriously the literary value of their choice. In addition to script

considerations, use of props and the onstage actions of the actors and actresses during a performance should not reflect gratuitous or inappropriate sexual content.

Certificate and Awards:

Society will Award the talented students with Certificates and Prizes.

The category of Awards:

1. Best actor
2. Best actress
3. Best Script
4. Best performance (overall)
5. Best team management (overall)
